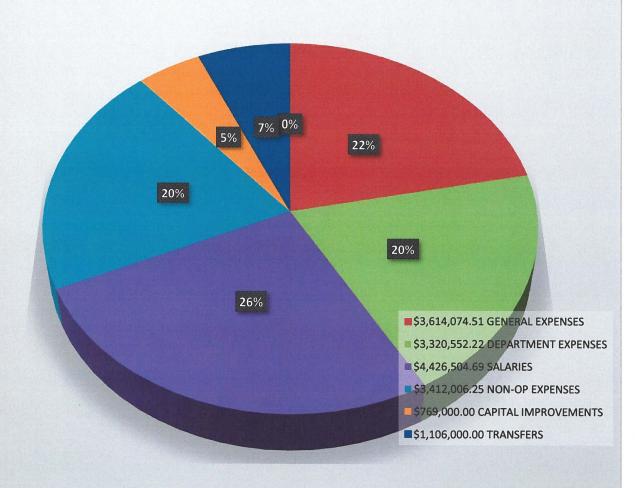
REVENUES 2023-2024
